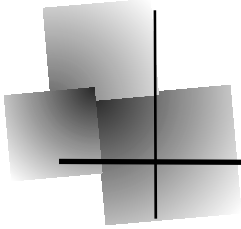

We do hope that you understand and accept the decisions made in the interest of your safety.



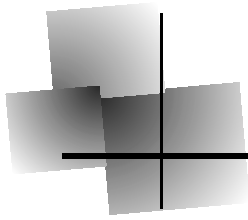
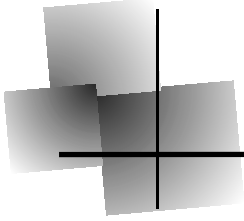

From first opening in 1989, to the present day, Crealy Great Adventure Park is designed and operated as an inclusive park. We do not discriminate on grounds of ability, age, race, culture, sexuality or orientation. The attitude of guests, however, will inevitably influence service levels!

All staff are enabled to recognise individual needs of guests and will give the best possible assistance. They are here to help, so don't be afraid to ask.

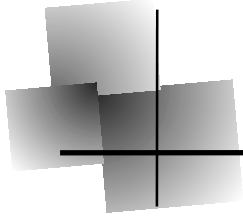
Here are just a few more ways that we hope to make your visit to Crealy Great Adventure Park just a little bit more enjoyable.

- Paths and access ways are designed and built to be wide and level or slightly sloping, with hard surfacing where possible and appropriate.
- Large print is used where possible and appropriate. Lower case text is used as much as possible.
- Visible and audible instructions are given where possible and appropriate, including all rides.
- Restaurant and picnic tables are designed to accommodate wheelchair users.
- Catering ingredients are available and staff will make special preparations, i.e. cut up/liquidise food.
- Wheelchairs are available for hire (pre-arranged).
- Necessary carers are admitted free of charge on a 1:1 basis.
- Extended tickets and annual memberships are available to guests and especially suitable to those affected by limited energy/concentration.

General Information

ACCESS

The park can be accessed easily by wheelchair users or those with limited mobility. However, the park is predominantly a natural environment so uneven surfaces and changes in levels are to be expected away from the built environment and hard paths.



Our guest's safety is our prime concern and, as such, Crealy Great Adventure Park reserves the right to refuse admission to a ride or facility if we feel that your safety or the safety of others may be at risk. Some of our rides are not suitable for some forms of disability. However, we will endeavour to accommodate disabled guests whenever it is safe to do so. Most of our rides are clearly visible and we recommend that you observe their operation before queuing or ask a Ranger for advice.

PARKING

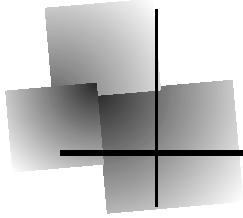
Parking for disabled guests is available in the Early Bird Car Park, adjacent to Reception. Guests with disabled badges may park in these designated spaces. Please note that there is a limited number of disabled parking spaces.

SIGNAGE

Large print information is available at various points around the park.

FIRST AID

Our First Aid station is located at the top of the Park right next to the entrance to the Animal Realm Barn. If the first aider is not present, you may contact Reception, using the internal telephone inside the First Aid station, who will then contact a qualified First Aider. Alternatively notify a Ranger who will be more than happy to assist you. The First Aid station is accessible to guests in wheelchairs.



General Information

TOILETS

Many of the toilet facilities around the park also incorporate baby changing areas and lowered hand wash basins. Toilets for disabled guests are available at the following locations:

- At the top of the park, opposite the Adventure Zone — may not be suitable for larger wheelchairs.
- In the centre of the park, opposite the Queen Bess Pirate Ship.
- In the Magical Kingdom—may not be suitable for larger wheelchairs.
- In Crealy Bear Café.

TELEPHONES

A public telephone is available in the foyer of Crealy Bear Cafe. Alternatively, there is a telephone in the main gift shop which you may use. A small donation to charity will be requested for the use of this telephone.

RIDES

Guests with special needs will require the assistance of an accompanying friend or carer to enjoy some rides or facilities.

Where ride access for guests in wheelchairs is through the exit, guests must wait for instruction for the Ride Master Ranger before entering the ride/platform area.



The Realms

You are warmly invited to discover a wonderful day of magical adventures at Crealy, where we're never too busy to take good care of you! With six realms, there's far more fun than you can fit into one visit—so come along and let us treat you to our Devon hospitality!



The Realm designed for our more active guests, with a River Challenge, Bumper Boats, Techno Race Karts, and the sensational Summer Splash Zone. Take the plunge on the Tidal Wave log flume.

The Animal Realm is the heart of the Park, where we aim to encourage greater understanding of and respect for animals through supervised handling and information. Animal Showtime involves you in one very special day – and the chance to meet, groom, ride and cuddle Devon's friendliest animals in the Crealy Close Encounters and Personal Pony Rides.



The Adventure Realm is designed for all the family to play together. We aim to enable children to discover their own capabilities and courage through adventurous play. Remember: it's never too late to have a happy childhood!

Pan for gold in El Dorado, board the Queen Bess Pirate Ship, ride El Loco and our Victorian Carousel. The Adventure Zone has 75,000 square feet and you can feast in the Adventure Cafe, Hungry Farmer and Crealy Bear Cafe!

The Realms

The Magic Realm is especially for our littlest guests. The safe magic of the Kingdom's Honey Swing and three play areas are dedicated to the under fives. Explore the Fairy Trail, Tree Tops Playground, the Littleland Children's Village, Prince's Train and Sahara Sands. The Fantasy Café does good food fast!

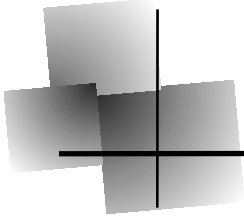


Crealy nestles within 100 acres of beautiful East Devon countryside. Take the Prairie Train to Dragonfly Lake, picnic amongst wildflowers and unearth nature's bounty along the Natural High Way and Poetry Plantation.



Serving as a modern interpretation of modern West Country farming, in this Realm you can see the cute piglets, bottle-feed lambs and kids, milk our patient house-cows for your Certificate of Udderance!





River Challenge

Situated on the outer edge of the park, the River Challenge is a series of fifteen bridges, across The Grindle Brook, presenting a variety of different challenges.

- Access:** Available alongside the river side.
- Special Conditions:** Must be able to access a series of difficult bridges. If in a wheelchair you must keep to the tarmac pathway running along the park side of the River Challenge.
- Height Restriction:** There is no height restriction on this attraction.

Bumper Boats

Situated in the centre of the park, the Bumper Boats are self-driven, motorised two seater boats.



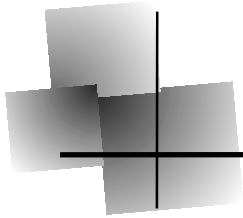
- Access:** Disabled guests can enter the ride through the gate adjacent to the go-kart track. Guests must be able to negotiate a step down into the boats.
- Special Conditions:** Riders must possess good upper body control, they should be in good health and should be free from motion sickness, heart, back, neck or other problems which may be aggravated by this ride. There is no restraint and guests must be able to hold on tightly. This ride is not recommended for pregnant women due to it's nature.

Techno Race Karts

Situated between the Bumper Boats and Littleland, these are self-driven single and double seater karts. T-shirts and suitable footwear must be worn.

- Access:** The queuing area is accessible for wheelchairs., although there is a ramp up to the queuing area. Guests will also need to negotiate a series of steps to get into a kart.
- Special Conditions:** Guests wishing to drive one of the karts must have adequate vision and the ability to steer and to depress the pedals. In the event of an emergency guests will have to get out of the karts on the track. Assistance will be available, if required. All guests should possess good upper body control and should be free from back, neck or other problems which may be aggravated by this ride. This ride is not recommended for pregnant women due to it's nature. Audio instructions are given on this ride.
- Height Restriction:** Single rides must be above 1.48m. Double rides must be over 1.48m and aged over 16yrs, passengers must be over 2yrs and below 1.48m.
- Cost:** £4.00 per kart.





Tidal Wave

Situated next to the Magical Kingdom, this is Devon's only double drop flume.

- Access:** Access is available through the usual entrance.
- Special Conditions:** Riders will need to possess good upper body control, should be in good health and should be free of motion sickness, heart, back, neck and other problems which may be aggravated by this ride. Guests must be able to step down into moving boat. If emergency evacuation is necessary, guests will have to manoeuvre along narrow walkways and steep steps. This ride is not recommended for pregnant women because of its nature. Riders must have mental ability and awareness to determine danger and they must have a rational fear of heights.
- Height Restrictions:** Between 0.92m and 1m must be accompanied by someone over 16 years. Guests must also be over 7 years to ride alone.

WaterWalkerz:

- Access:** Access is available through the usual entrance.
- Weight restrictions:** Max weight of 14 stone, min age of 5.
- Special Conditions:** Guests who suffer from claustrophobia, asthma or stress from close spaces may experience distress. All jewellery, pins and shoes must be removed. Expectant mothers or guests with broken bones cannot use this attraction.

Mini Karts, Bikes & Tractors

Situated in three areas, in Littleland and next to the Techno Race Karts and within the Magical Kingdom these are self-driven mini electric vehicles especially designed for small children.

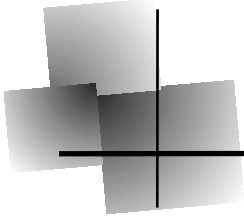
- Access:** Access is gained through the usual entrance.
- Special Conditions:** Riders must possess good upper body control, should be in good health and should be free from motion sickness, heart, back, neck or other problems which may be aggravated by this ride. There are no restraints and guests must be able to hold on tightly. Guests must be able to steer a kart and press a pedal.
- Height Restrictions:** The Mini Karts are designed for children and adults should not attempt to drive them.
- Cost:** 50p or £1 per kart.

Summer Soak Zone

Situated at the outskirts of the park, this facility features fountains and water sprays, which are activated by pressure pads.

- Access:** Assistance is required to negotiate the sliding wall and/or water wall. Alternatively, access for those with special needs is gained by following the footpath around the lake and past the River Challenge.
- Special Conditions:** Outdoor shoes and clothing should be removed and swim wear worn. Wheelchairs must be able to withstand water but wheels should first be washed off in the shower provided.
- Height Restrictions:** There are no height restrictions.





Maximus Coaster

Situated in the centre of the park, it is visible from the entrance. This is a small roller coaster, “pink knuckle ride” with a double-run of drops and twists.



- Access:** Wheelchair users are advised to use the exit area to access the ride platform. Access is ramped.
- Special Conditions:** Riders should possess good upper body control, should be in good health and free from motion sickness, heart, back, neck or other problems which may be aggravated by this ride. If emergency evacuation is necessary, guests will have to exit via from the thirty foot walkway of steps. This ride is not recommended for pregnant women due to it’s nature and the restraints. Guests must have assistance to get in and out of the ride.
- Height Restrictions:** Between 0.92m and 1.1m must be accompanied by someone over 16 years — to ride alone guests must be 1.1m and a minimum of 7 years.

Vortex Water Coaster

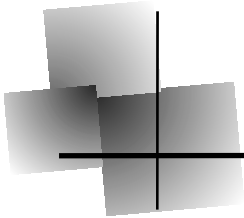
Situated between the carousel and pony rides, you can’t miss it!

- Access:** Wheelchair users can access the ride from the sloping ramp.
- Special Conditions:** To make access as easy as possible for wheelchair users, the ride is open to wheelchair users only between 5pm and 5.30pm daily. Riders should possess good upper body control, be in good health and free from motion sickness, heart, back, neck or other problems which may be exaggerated by this ride. Emergency evacuation is from the entrance ramp, or down the tubes if guests are already in boats. Guests must have assistance to get out of the ride and someone to bring the wheelchair to the bottom of the ride. “Viper” the largest tube, has smoke effect and is not suitable for guests with breathing difficulties
- Height Restrictions:** Children between 0.92m and 1.2m can ride with an adult aged over 16. Children under 0.92m cannot ride. Over 1.2m you can ride unaccompanied.

Queen Bess Pirate Ship & Pirate’s Revenge

Situated opposite the El Loco Family Roller Coaster, this is a “pink knuckle, pendulum ride” themed as a swinging boat, with an adjacent outdoor play area of climbing nets, frames and slides.

- Access:** Wheelchair users are advised to use the exit area to access the ride platform. Access is ramped.
- Special Conditions:** Riders should possess good upper body control, should be in good health and free from motion sickness, heart, back, neck or other problems which may be aggravated by this ride. If emergency evacuation is necessary, guests will have to walk down from the thirty foot walkway. This ride is not recommended for pregnant women due to it’s nature and the restraints. Guests must have assistance to get in and out of the ride. Audio instructions are given on this ride.
- Height Restrictions:** Between 0.9m and 1.25m must be accompanied by someone over 16 years and sit in the middle of a row with an adult on either side.
Pirates revenge is a hard play unsupervised area, parents to supervise children.



Victorian Carousel

Situated directly in the middle of the park, this is a traditional 19th century carousel with both horses and carts.

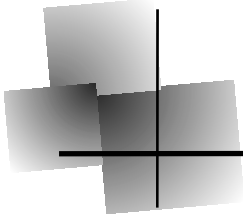
- Access:** There is a flat approach to the carousel. However, there are then three steps up to the horses.
- Special Conditions:** Riders must possess total body control and must be able to climb up onto the horses and cars. This ride is not recommended for pregnant women, due to it's nature. Please note that there is no form of restraint. Guests must be able to hold on.
- Height Restrictions:** Under 1.1m must be accompanied by someone over 16 years on the same horse or car.

El Dorado Gold Rush

Situated between the Swinging Queen Bess and Crealy Bear Cafe. This attraction features a series of troughs from which gold can be panned.



- Access:** Access is available via the usual entrance. Troughs are positioned at four different levels.
- Special Conditions:** Guests must possess upper body control to enjoy this feature.
- Height Restrictions:** There are no height restrictions.
- Cost:** £2.50 per pan.



Adventure Zone

Situated at the top of a natural slope. This indoor facility features a variety of slides, ball pools and padded play areas.

Access: Access is gained via the usual entrance.

Special Conditions: Once inside the building, some areas are not accessible to guests using wheelchairs. See details of individual features for further information.

Height Restrictions: There are no height restrictions in force within the Adventure Zone.

Red Devil Slide: This is a drop slide. Guests will need to negotiate approximately 25 — 30 steps.

Simulator: Situated at the entrance to the Adventure Zone, there are three steps up into the simulator which will need to be negotiated. Guests may need assistance to get in and out of the ride. There is no access for wheelchairs. Once inside, guests should possess good upper body control, should be in good health and free from motion sickness, heart, back, neck or other problems which may be aggravated by this ride. This ride is not recommended for pregnant women due to its nature. Close environment and movement may cause distress.

Astro Zoomer Slides: These are undulating slides and access is gained by negotiating approximately 25 — 30

Waterfall Slide: Accessed by negotiating approximately 25—30 steps, this slide features a double drop into a ball pool.

Go Wild: Situated in Dina's lost world, hard play area which may cause bumps and bruises. 2 access points situated on either side of the playframe, which are joined with tunnels, slopes and steps. A path leads to the outside canopy which looks over the park. Guests are advised to wear shoes to avoid injury. Although there is a Ranger present operating the ride, parents are advised to supervise their children.

Arcades: The Arcade is situated inside the Adventure Zone to the left of the sliding doors. There are no restrictions in the Adventure Zone Arcade.

Meteorite

Access: Through the usual entrance.

Special Conditions: Guests with disabilities will need assistance to get into seats.

Height Restrictions: Riders must be over 92cm to ride unaccompanied.

Dizzy Dina Ride

Access: Through the usual entrance

Special Conditions: Guests in wheelchairs can be wheeled to seats, they will need to be assisted on the seats.

Height Restrictions: Riders must be over 92cm to ride unaccompanied.

Climbing Wall

Access: Through the usual entrance

Special Conditions: Restrictions depend on disability

Berry Blasters

Access: No access for wheelchairs, guests should be directed to Battle of the Bears for disabled access.

Battle of the Bears

Access: Through the usual entrance. There are two emergency exits which are suitable for wheelchairs.

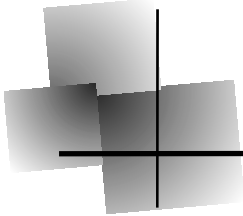
Special conditions: There are no restrictions. Limited light which may cause distress

Water Walkerz

Access: Through normal entrance

Special Conditions: Very closed environment, may get very hot.

Age/ Weight restrictions: Maximum weight 14 stone. Minimum age 4 years old



Woodlands Wilderness

Is situated on the edge of the Park past the soak zone.

- Access:** Over the widest bridge
- Special Conditions:** There are no special conditions, though wheelchair users should be aware that this is a natural environment with uneven ground in places.
- Height Restrictions:** None.

Stables

Situated in the Animal Barn, this feature is an opportunity for guests to meet ponies and miniature horses unique to the British Isles.

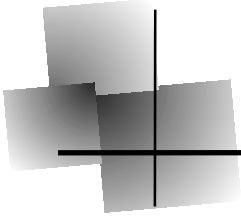
- Access:** Access is gained through the usual entrance. There is a small ramp up into the barn, in which the stables are situated. Once inside the stables, the floor surface is uneven in places.
- Special Conditions:** There are no special restrictions in this facility, although minors should be accompanied by an adult and guests should remember that animals can bite. This area is not recommended for guests with immunodeficiency due to contact with animals.
- Height Restrictions:** There are no height restrictions in the Stables.

Pony Rides

Situated, during fine weather, in the gymkhana arena, adjacent to the entrance of Animal Land. During periods of inclement weather, Pony Rides will be cancelled.

- Access:** Access is gained through the usual entrance although guests should be aware that the surface of the Gymkhana Arena is sand. Steps up to the ponies are available.
- Special Conditions:** Riders should possess good total body control, should be in good health and free from motion sickness, heart, back, neck or other problems which may be aggravated by this ride. Guests should be able to hold the saddle tightly and grip with their knees. Guests must have assistance to get on and off the ponies. This area is not recommended for guests with immunodeficiency due to contact with animals.
- Height/ weight Restrictions:** There are no height restrictions for the pony rides. There is a maximum weight restriction of 8 stone
- Cost:** £3.00 per ride.





Animal and Dina Showtime

Situated in the Animal Barn. Our Animal Showtime is an informative, entertaining and interactive show on West Country farming featuring a selection of our animals.

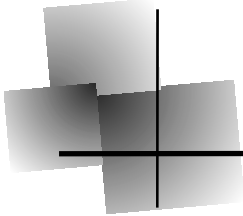
- Access:** Access is gained through the usual entrance. There is a small ramp up into the arena.
- Special Conditions:** The Animal Showtime is watched from the tiered seating area. However, the show can also be viewed in comfort around the periphery of the arena. This area is not recommended for guests with immunodeficiency due to contact with animals.
- Height Restrictions:** There are no height restrictions for the Animal Showtime.

Animal Nursery

Situated in the Animal Barn, this facility affords guests the opportunity to meet a variety of adult and baby animals, including, guinea pigs, rabbits, sheep, goats and cattle.

- Access:** Access is gained through the usual entrance. There are small ramps in and out of the Animal Barn and the floor surface is uneven in places.
- Special Conditions:** This area is not recommended for guests with immunodeficiency due to contact with animals.
- Height Restrictions:** There are no height restrictions in the Animal Nursery.





The Prince's Train

Situated in Littleland, the Prince's Train is a small track operated train for toddlers and smaller children.

Access: Access is gained through the usual entrance. Guests will need to negotiate a step up onto the train.

Special Conditions: Riders should be in good health and free from motion sickness or other problems which may be aggravated by this ride. If emergency evacuation is necessary, guests will be guided back along the track by a Ranger. Some guests may require assistance to get in and out of the ride.

Height Restrictions: Under 0.9m must be accompanied by someone over 16 years.



Sahara Sands

Situated next to the Prince's Train, Sahara Sands is a large sand pit for all ages.

Access: Access is gained via the usual entrance. There is a step down into the sand.

Special Conditions: There are no special conditions, however some guests may have their mobility impaired when traversing the sand pit.

Height Restrictions: There are no height restrictions.

Children's Village

Situated next to the Prince's Train, the Children's Village is a series of small building, especially designed for children to explore.

Access: Access is gained via the usual entrance.

Special Conditions: There are no special conditions associated with this feature.

Height Restrictions: There are no height restrictions associated with this feature, although there are some small doorways that are not suitable for wheelchair access.

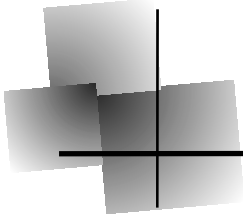
Honey Swing

Situated in the Magical Kingdom, the Honey Swing is a chair-o-plane carousel, designed with children and toddlers in mind.

Access: Access is gained through the usual entrance.

Special Conditions: Riders should be in good health and free from motion sickness or other problems which may be aggravated by this ride. If emergency evacuation is necessary, some guests may require assistance to get in and out of the ride. This ride is not recommended for pregnant women due to it's nature and the restraints.

Height Restrictions: Under 1.1m must be accompanied by someone over 16 years, not suitable for babies. Total weight per seat 90kg.



Magical Kingdom

Situated in the centre of the park opposite the Treetops Playground. This is an indoor facility special designed for small children and toddlers.

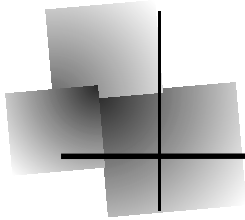
- Access:** Access is available via the usual entrances.
- Special Conditions:** There are no special conditions for entry into the Magical Kingdom. See each individual feature below for any special conditions.
- Height Restrictions:** There are no height restrictions to enter the Magical Kingdom. See each individual feature below for any height restrictions.
- Castle Play Frame:** This feature has different levels, slides and ball pools. Mobility is required to enjoy this feature. Children must be under 1.3m to use this attraction.
- Toddlers Garden:** This is an enclosed soft play area, specially designed for babies and toddlers to play in safety. Some mobility is required to enjoy this feature. This attraction is restricted to children under 0.8m tall.
- Blue Lagoon Play Frame:** This is a soft play area, specially designed with child safety and stimulation for babies and toddlers. This attraction is restricted to children under 0.9m tall.

Treetops Playground

Situated next to the Magical Kingdom, this facility is an outdoor play ground, which features slides, climbing frames, elevated walkways and a zip wire.

- Access:** Access is gained via the usual entrance. However, guests should be aware that the surface used for this feature is shredded bark.
- Special Conditions:** Full mobility and body control may be required to enjoy many of the features in the Treetops Playground. See each individual feature below for any special conditions.
- Height Restrictions:** There are no specific height restrictions to enter Treetops.
- Buzzard Swoop:** This is a 6 metre freefall drop slide. Mats are provided for guest use. There are approximately 20 narrow and steep steps and a ramp up to the Buzzard Swoop.
- Silver Slides:** This features comprises of three silver slides of different sizes. Mats are provided for guest use. There are approximately 26 narrow and steep steps and a ramp up to the silver slides.
- Squirrel Run:** The Squirrel Run connects all of the slides in the Treetops area. There are approximately 19 narrow and steep steps and a ramp up to the Squirrel Run.
- Woodentops Play Ground:** This playground is situated within the Treetops area and is specially designed for smaller children. The area is enclosed for added security and peace of mind.





Eating Out

Crealy Bear Cafe

Situated next to Battle of the Bears, offering a variety of hot and cold snacks. It is open every day of the summer and the busiest winter days. The cafe can be booked for birthday parties or for private functions. It is a fully licence bar. There are toilet facilities including a special needs toilet next to Battle of the Bears.

Access: There are three access points into the café, a sloped entrance opposite the fountain with double doors, a entrance leading in from the patio or access next to the Battle of the Bears. double doors.

Special Conditions There are no special conditions associated with Crealy Bear Café, although the main counter is waist height

Adventure Cafe

Situated in the Adventure Zone, selling a variety of fast foods, sandwiches and beverages. Hot food is served from 12 noon until 5 p.m. Times may differ.

Access: Access is gained through the usual entrance.

Special Conditions: There are no special conditions associated with the Adventure Cafe, although the counters are to waist height.



Fantasy Café

Situated in the Magical Kingdom, Fantasy Café offers a selection of fast foods, sandwiches and beverages. Hot food is sold from 12 noon until 5 p.m. Times may differ.

Access: Access is gained through the usual entrance.

Special Conditions: There are no special conditions associated with the Fantasy Cafe, although the main counter is to waist height, and there is a lowered counter.

Hungry Farmer

Situated on the path to the Tidal Wave, the Hungry Farmer offers a variety of hot food and beverages.

Access: Access is gained through the usual entrance.

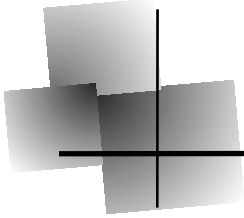
Special Conditions: There are no special conditions associated with the Hungry Farmer, although the counter is to waist height

Berries & Beans Juice Bar

Situated next to the Adventure Zone Café looking over the park. Hot and cold snacks can be purchased here, as well as a selection of non and alcoholic drinks as is a licence bar.

Access: Access is gained through the usual entrance

Special Conditions: There are no special conditions associated with the juice bar, although the main counter is to waist height, there is a lowered counter attached to the Juice Bar



Shopping

Main Gift Shop

Situated at the entrance to the park, the Main Gift Shop offers a range of books, confectionary, toys and souvenirs. The Gift Shop is open from 10 a.m. until park close.



Access: Access can be gained via the usual entrances.
Special Conditions: There are no special conditions associated with the Main Gift Shop.

Height Restrictions: There are no height restrictions in the Main Gift shop. Counters are to waist height. The Membership Point counter is split level so as to accommodate children and wheelchair users. This till point accepts all purchases in the gift shop.

Ice Cream Kiosk

Situated in the centre of the park, on the path to the Bumper Boats. The Ice Cream kiosk sells a variety of drinks and ice creams.

Access: Access can be gained at the usual serving point.
